



JAMES R. HOFFA MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FUND

James R. Hoffa became a Teamster member in 1933, served as General President for 14 years, and, in recognition of his tireless service to the Union and its members, was honored as General President Emeritus for life. At the November 1999 General Executive Board meeting, General Secretary-Treasurer C. Thomas Keegel presented a resolution to establish a new scholarship fund in recognition of Hoffa's outstanding contributions to the Union.

Separate from the annual scholarship for high school seniors, the James R. Hoffa Memorial Scholarship Fund Essay Contest will award one-time \$1,000.00 scholarships annually to 200 students. **All applicants must comply with the following eligibility criteria.**

- 1. Be the son, daughter or financial dependent of an eligible Teamster member, hereafter also referred to as "Teamster Member Relation";
- 2. Be enrolled full-time in an undergraduate college, university or community college program, or a technical or vocational program;
- 3. Be 23 years old or younger by June 15, 2016.

The applicant's Teamster Member Relation** must be able to demonstrate that:

- 1. He/she was a member in "good standing" per Article X, Section 5 of the International Constitution.
- 2. He/she was retired from a craft represented by his or her Local Union and was a member in "good standing" as per Article X, Section 5 of the International Constitution for 5 years prior to his/her retirement.
- 3. He/she was not a full-time elected officer during the relevant period of good standing listed above.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

- 1. Applicant and Teamster Member Relation must complete questions #1-10.
- 2. Applicant must attach, on a separate sheet, a type-written essay of 500 words or less. (Essays will not be returned.)
- 3. Applicant must forward the completed application and essay to the James R. Hoffa Memorial Scholarship Fund office by June 15, 2016. Though email is preferred we will accept hard copies. We cannot allow any extensions to this deadline.

2016 ESSAY TOPIC:

"What has living in a Teamster household meant to me and my siblings?"

Only completed applications will be considered. Essays will be reviewed by a panel of independent labor educators and the winners will be selected based on the quality and content of the applicant's response. The Selection Committee will consider all applications without regard to race, religion, gender, disability, or any other legally protected status. If requested, winners should be prepared to submit their essay electronically.

If the Teamster Member Relation is no longer a member in good standing, the scholarship may be forfeited. Hoffa Scholarship Fund to publish all or part of his/her essay in any union or scholarship related publication or electronic format.
