- If applicant is a recurring award recipient, there must be a confirmation of their enrollment in school with a list of courses being taken.
- If an applicant transfers or withdraws from school, for any reason, TNBC Chicago Chapter must be notified at once.

- Failure to comply with any provisions of these directions or falsifying information will result in automatic disqualification.
- The Executive Board of TNBC Chicago Chapter will make the final decision and contact you. Awards will be based on the completed essays including grammar and spelling, and your current grade point average. Only one recipient per household per year.
