OSCO DRUG EMPLOYEE HEALTHCARE INSURANCE PROGRAM

BACKGROUND

Insurance carrier is BC/BS of Idaho.

 Osco Rx's have same carrier and plan as other Osco employees, including management.

EMPLOYEE COMPENSATION PACKAGE

- Osco's Rx total compensation package is designed to compete within the retail pharmacy industry. This includes the healthcare insurance plan and employee premium contributions.
- Our primary competition <u>CVS and Walgreens</u> are the focus.

EMPLOYEE COMPENSATION PACKAGE (CON'T.)

Wage Rates*

- 1. Osco: \$2,602/wk. or \$65.05/hr.
- 2. Walgreens: \$2,580/wk. or \$64.50/hr.
 - 3. CVS: \$2,572.00/wk. or \$64.30/hr.

EMPLOYEE COMPENSATION PACKAGE (CON'T.)

401(k) / Retirement

- For three (3) consecutive years, Osco matched 50% of employee contributions up to 7% of individual total earnings.
- In 2015, Osco contributed \$4,699.72 (\$2.26/hr.) to each full-time Rx who made the maximum contribution of 7% to their 401(k).
- We believe this is competitive with CVS and Walgreens.

INSURANCE AND EMPLOYEE PREMIUM CONTRIBUTIONS

- Osco Rx's have contribution rates appropriate for the segment of the business they work within.
- We believe CVS offers unionized Rx's <u>only high-deductible</u> <u>plan options</u>. This means that the employee premium contribution rates are lower, but the out-of-pocket expenses are <u>significantly higher than under Osco's plan</u>.

OSCO'S POSITION AND PROPOSAL

- For these reasons, Osco cannot agree to Union's current healthcare insurance proposal.
- It would not be competitive with CVS and Walgreens.

OSCO'S POSITION AND PROPOSAL (CON'T.)

- The contract between Osco and IBT 727 does not include specific limits on employee healthcare insurance contribution rates.
- Osco's goal is to remain competitive with Walgreens and CVS while providing a greater degree of cost certainty to its employees.
- Osco will propose to limit annual increases to employee healthcare insurance contribution rates.

CONCLUSIONS / SUMMARY

- Osco is competitive with CVS and Walgreens in its total compensation package:
 - Our Rx's receive the highest wages and we have already offered a raise.
 - Our 401(k) plan provides significant value (up to \$2.26/hour in 2015) to employees who participate.
 - Healthcare insurance premium contributions are competitive.
- Osco's goal is to competitive in these areas. In addition, we wish to provide a greater degree of cost-certainty to employees in the area of healthcare insurance.
- Osco will therefore propose to place limits on employee insurance contribution rates.
