Lifesource Members Benefit from New Safety Protocol Secured In Latest Contract

When LifeSource workers represented by Teamsters Local 727 ratified their latest contract on August 14, they locked down a vital new benefit — safety training.

Following a web-based defensive driving course, three safety meetings were held throughout the day on September 29 for LifeSource members at the company's Rosemont facility. Thanks to new requirements negotiated by Local 727, these safety meetings now will be held quarterly.

The meetings give LifeSource members a chance to voice their concerns about safety at work and create a more efficient work environment. During the meeting on September 29, members were able to address several new issues with management, including ice on the loading dock steps during the winter, the size of small supply trucks and the absence of an air filter in older trucks.
