THE NATIONAL LABOR RELATIONS ACT GIVES YOU THE RIGHT TO:

- Form, join, or assist a union;
- Choose a representative to bargain with us on your behalf;
- Act together with other employees for your benefit and protection;
- Choose not to engage in any of these protected activities.

WE WILL NOT interfere with, restrain, or coerce you in the exercise of the above rights.

WE WILL NOT refuse to provide Teamsters, Local 727 (Union) with information that is relevant and necessary to its role as your bargaining representative.

WE HAVE provided the Union with Items 1, 5 and 8 contained within the Union's April 14, 2020 information request; and **WE WILL** provide the Union with Item #9 from the Union's April 14, 2020 information request.
